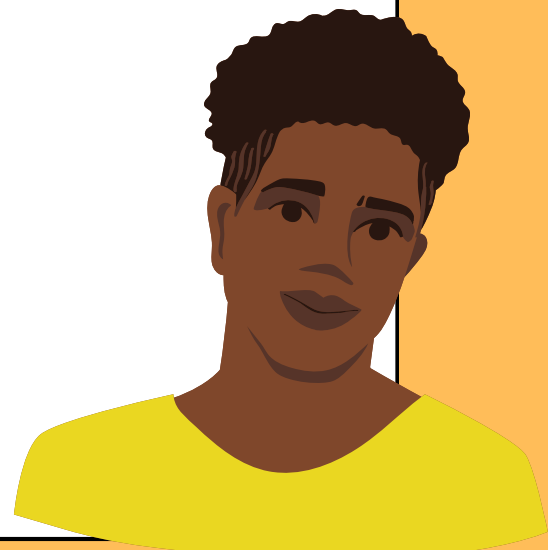


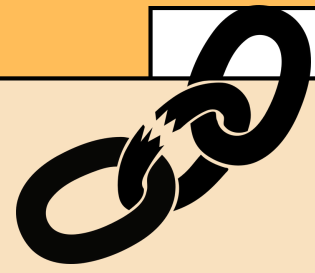
Emancipation Day



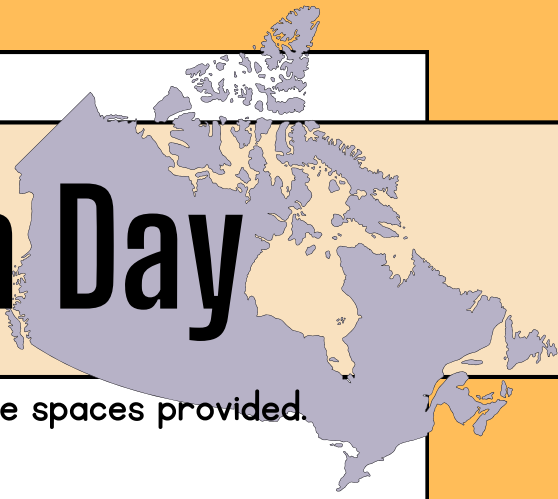

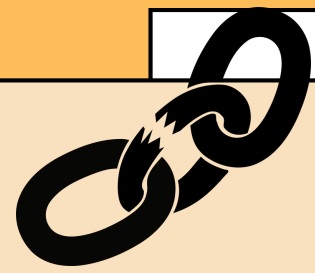

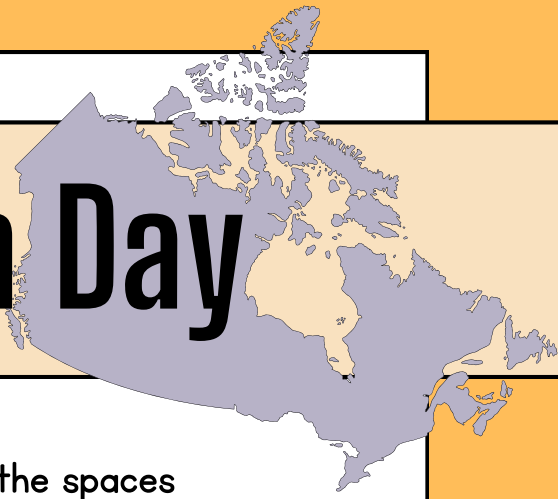
